DESCRIPTION

Eighty Acres is a range of wines that is refreshingly down to earth. In South Australia the best land for grape growing was originally sold in eighty acre blocks. In 1969 our grandfather Bill Taylor planted our first eighty acres of vines in some of the best terra rossa soil in the Clare Valley and named the block "Eighty Acres". The soil from the block features on the front label.

The fruit for this wine was sourced from the Taylor family estate in the Clare Valley and also from a grower in the Adelaide Hills. Harvesting began on the 1st February 2008 and continued until the 19th March. The fruit was picked during the cool of the night to ensure the delicate varietal flavours were retained. The berries were de-stemmed and then gently pressed. Each parcel was fermented separately using varietally specific yeast strains in stainless steel vessels. Post fermentation the separate parcels of wine were blended and prepared for bottling. Minimal filtration was employed prior to the wine being bottled.

WINE COLOUR

At release the wine is a pale straw with a slight green tinge to the edge.

WINE BOUQUET

The wine has very lifted, fresh aroma of tropical fruit, passionfruit, lemon, lime and a subtle rosewater character.

WINE PALATE

The wine has clean, fresh flavours of citrus and a touch of spice. The mid palate displays guava and

melon characters with an overall well-balanced acidity. The finish is refreshing and fruity.

SUGGESTED FOOD MATCHING

Try it with salt and pepper squid or even a haloumi and rocket salad.
