COLOUR

At release the wine is a dark red colour with ruby red hues.

NOSE

The wine has a seductive, lifted aroma characterised by plum, blackcurrant and dark cherry fruits along with subtle chocolate and a touch of oak derived spice.

PALATE

On the palate, this is a medium to full-bodied wine with a luscious mouthfeel. There are intense, perfectly ripened fruit flavours of plum and blackberry complemented by subtle spice and mocha coffee characters. The alluring, oak characters are framed with an elegant acid line and the wine is completed by a finish that lingers most enjoyably.

OAK MATURATION

The wine was matured for 18 months in premium American oak followed by fining, minimal filtration and then bottling.

CELLARING NOTES

Crafted for immediate enjoyment but will cellar over a medium term under ideal conditions.
