At release, the wine is a deep, dark red with purple hues.

NOSE

There are lifted dark berry and raspberry aromas along with subtle spice, black pepper and mocha overtones from the oak maturation.

PALATE

This is a lush, mouth filling wine with intense black cherry, plum, raspberry & some earthy undertones. The oak maturation brings attractive spice and mocha characters to the palate. The wine is medium to full-bodied with great balance, well integrated oak and the finish is persistent and imminently enjoyable.

OAK MATURATION


American oak was employed for its ability to deliver robust characters. After maturing in oak for a period of 10 months, the wine was blended, filtered and bottled.
